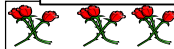

RCIA- The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a spiritual journey by which adults enter into the Catholic faith. It is a process of seeking, reflection, learning, celebration, growth and commitment. It is an ancient process that was practiced by the early Church. The first step in the journey is a period of inquiry. This is also a period of evangelization on the part of the Church. At the end of this period, having reached a point on initial conversion, and wishing to continue their journey,

candidates are accepted into the Order of Catechumens. During this period, the catechumens continue with more intense preparation, which leads to the celebration of the sacraments of initiation.
