FROM THE DIOCESE OF JACKSON- An allegation of sexual abuse of a minor female by Deacon Rick Caldwell has been brought forward to the Diocese of Jackson Fitness Review Board. The allegation has been considered and found to be credible. His faculties have been suspended as of July 24, 2018 and he has been removed from ministry. He is no longer free to function as a Deacon. This case has been reported to civil authorities and the Diocese of Jackson will cooperate with the investigation.

Anyone who has been a victim of abuse or exploitation by clergy, religious or lay church personnel and has not yet reported it is encouraged to do so. The Diocese of Jackson places no deadline or time limits on reporting. The Victim Assistance Coordinator, Valerie McClellan and Vicar General, Fr.
